

B-162 RHODINILE BLUE STAIN

Fixation: None

PROCEDURE:

1. To a few drops of heparinized or EDTA-treated blood, add an equal amount of **Rhodinile Blue Stain** (B-162-1). Swirl gently and let stand 2 minutes.
2. Prepare thin smears and air dry.
3. Smears can be examined as usual or can be mounted with a synthetic resin.

Stain Results:

Deep Purple	Heinz Bodies
Yellow-Orange to Blue-Green	Erythrocytes
Blue	Reticulocytes
